

The National Innovation Visa (NIV), also known as the 858 visa, is a permanent residency visa aimed at attracting high-caliber global talents, entrepreneurs, investors, and leaders in various fields such as science, technology, business, the arts, and more. This visa will be officially implemented on December 6, 2024, replacing the current Global Talent Visa (GTI).

Key Features

• Eligible Applicants

Individuals with outstanding achievements in fields such as science, technology, business, the arts, and sports, including globally recognized researchers, innovative entrepreneurs, high-caliber investors, and representatives who can contribute significantly to Australia's international talent ecosystem.
